THE TICONDERAGO (sic) - Dr Hunt, the Health Officer at Williams Town (sic), who returned yesterday from the Heads, informs us that the people by the above vessel, are taken out of her; the healthy are living on shore at Point Nepean; about thirty cases of fever still remain; these are on board the *Lysander*, anchored near. The arrangements made for their comfort are all very creditable, and all are daily supplied with ample rations of fresh meat, vegetables etc; the deaths average two to three daily.
