The Ticonderago (sic), from Liverpool, which vessel has been in quarantine for the last six weeks, at the Heads, anchored amongst the shipping in the bay yesterday, bringing up all the healthy immigrants, the diseased ones being on shore at Point Nepean, and the worst cases on board the Lysander, moored near the latter place.
